On 11/22/2022 at 1:00 p.m. EST, the SMCX will host the “*Identifying and Reporting Your SMS Trends*” workshop.

This workshop focuses on your trend analysis process. It provides information on leading and lagging indicators of safety and health (S&H) performance, actions to address S&H trends, and presenting trend results. The workshop includes activities to help establish a robust trend analysis program, including: differentiating between leading and lagging indicators, developing a plan to manage monitoring and measurement information, and reviewing example S&H data sets to identify trends. The workshop concludes with ideas for using your trend results and action plan to improve your safety management system (SMS).
