REMINDER – Post your 2019 Work-Related Summary of Injuries and Illnesses – OSHA Form 300A

The SMCX is posting this reminder for all employers of your obligation to post a copy of your <u>OSHA Form 300A</u>, your summary of jobrelated injuries and illnesses logged during calendar 2018. Employers must post this summary every year from February 1 to April 30, displayed in a common area where notices to employees usually get posted. Businesses exempt from OSHA recordkeeping and posting requirements are those with 10 or fewer employees and those in certain low-hazard industries.
