Did you remember to post your 2020 OSHA Form 300A, Summary of Work-Related Injuries & Illnesses?

The SMCX is posting this reminder for all employers of your obligation to post a copy of your OSHA Form 300A, your summary of job-related injuries and illnesses logged during calendar 2020. Employers must post this summary every year from February 1 to April 30, displayed in a common area where notices to employees usually get posted. Businesses exempt from OSHA recordkeeping and posting requirements are those with 10 or fewer employees and those in certain low-hazard industries.
