

# Locking Down Compliance: An Overview of OSHA's LOTO Regulation

On 10/21/2021 at 1:00 p.m. EDT, the SMCX will host the “*Locking Down Compliance: An Overview of OSHA's LOTO Regulation*” webinar.

This webinar focuses on the components of the OSHA Control of Hazard Energy standard, 29 CFR 1910.147, otherwise known as lockout/tagout (LOTO). It helps attendees determine whether LOTO is applicable to a task, and if so, what to include in an energy control procedure (ECP). This webinar identifies LOTO devices and reviews the requirements for conducting periodic inspections of ECPs. It also examines the different categories of employees impacted by LOTO and the types of training and topics applicable to each category.
