SOHMS = safety and occupational health management system

The website contains information about the DoD SMCX, headlines on upcoming events and SOH topics, and educational and training resources available for download.

It has a frequently updated Star Map that shows any DoD site that received formal recognition for their SOHMS. The Star Map shows if there are DoD Star sites located nearby which could serve as a mentor.

You can find examples of "good" documentation and best practices collected during DoD SMCX on-site assessments on the website, as well. Review these examples if you have trouble developing a document. There is a variety of examples ranging from SOH programs, policy letters, and much more!

The SMCX holds monthly webinars and several workshops throughout the year. Use the website to stay up-to-date on these events and register for ones you are interested in.

Subscribe to the mailing list to receive emails about new webinars and workshops, on-site courses, and other news that may impact you or your organization.

You must be registered on the website and have an active account to subscribe to the mailing list.

Typically, you need print handouts and documents ahead of time to prepare for the workshop. These documents and other relevant information is uploaded to the website a few days before the workshop.

One pagers give you specific information about SOH and SOHMS topics in a short document.

The DoD SMCX produces one pagers based on worksite needs or observations made during onsite assessments. They provide clarification on specific topics and various SOHMS.
